Our Pope Says. "No vocation is born of itself or lives for itself. A vocation flows from the heart of God and blossoms in the good soil of faithful people.

- *We need to Pray* for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life. Jesus says in Matthew 9:38 "to beg the master of the harvest to send laborers into the vineyard." If we want more priests, sisters and brothers, we all need to ask.
- *Teach* young people to hear God calling them into a deeper relationship with Him and into the discipleship of the Church.
- *Invite* active young adults and teens to consider a vocation to the priesthood or consecrated life.
- *Make it attractive*. Show that it is a call to be spiritual father /mother to the whole family of faith. to be united to Christ in a unique way
- **Preach it, brother!** Vocations kept out of sight are out of mind. Talk about it at Home too !
