MARRIAGE

Do not book a hall or choose music until you have spoken to the priest. If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

Mass Etiquette

For Catholics, the Mass is a very solemn and sacred event in which they are renewed in faith by their encounter with the Real Presence of Jesus Christ and grow as a communion together with the universal Church. In light of its sacred nature, it is both helpful and important to keep a few things in mind when attending Mass:

1. Please arrive in the Church before the Mass begins. It is **disruptive to others to arrive after the Mass has begun..** The opening and closing of doors, the movement of people to their pews and the general disturbance of people arriving late is very distracting and negatively impacts the rhythm of the Mass.
2. **Chewing gum is NEVER appropriate at mass.**
3. **Cell phones ringing, buzzing or people texting is highly inappropriate.** Please turn off your phones prior to the Mass beginning. It is NEVER appropriate to answer your phone in the Church or to make a call. Emergencies are obvious exceptions..
4. **How we dress is a sign of our interior disposition, and is an external symbol of the reverence which we carry in our hearts when attending mass.** Thus, it is a part of how we witness to the respect in which we hold the mass. It is not appropriate for men to wear shorts or t-shirts at Mass. It is also not appropriate for women to dress immodestly. During mass Men must never not wear a hat or cap while women may wear something covering their heads. No one should wear sunglasses in the church unless for health reasons.
5. **Silence is most appreciated in the Church. The Church is a House of Prayer, please refrain from carrying conversations in the Church.**
6. We always welcome children to be an active and joyful part of our parish community. While parents need the support and understanding of the community when their infants and toddlers momentarily cry or become fidgety or feel unwell, parents are also encouraged to be mindful of the other members of the community who have gathered in the expectation of participating in the mass with focussed attention. Moreover, **Children should never be allowed to wander around the church. Instead, they should remain with their family.**

Prior to Mass

1. As you enter into the Church it is part of our custom to bless ourselves with Holy Water by making the Sign of the Cross. This ritual is also repeated upon leaving the Church. It is a reminder of our Baptism, that we are children of God, and members of the Body of Christ which is the Church.
2. When we select our seats but prior to entering the pew, it is important to make a genuflection as a sign of reverence and respect for the Real Presence of Jesus in the tabernacle. To make a proper genuflection, face the tabernacle and bend the right knee to touch the ground, as a sign of our acknowledgement of Jesus' Divinity.
3. When we have found our seat, a helpful means of preparing ourselves for the mass is to kneel in prayer briefly. This is a great opportunity to offer to God thanksgiving or make our petitions that we intend to pray for during Mass.

Holy Communion

As Catholics, we fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when we receive Holy Communion. We are encouraged to receive Communion devoutly and frequently. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, however, participants should not be conscious of grave a mortal sin and normally should have fasted for one hour.

Frequent reception of the Sacrament of Penance Reconciliation is encouraged for everyone.

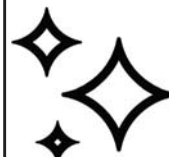
