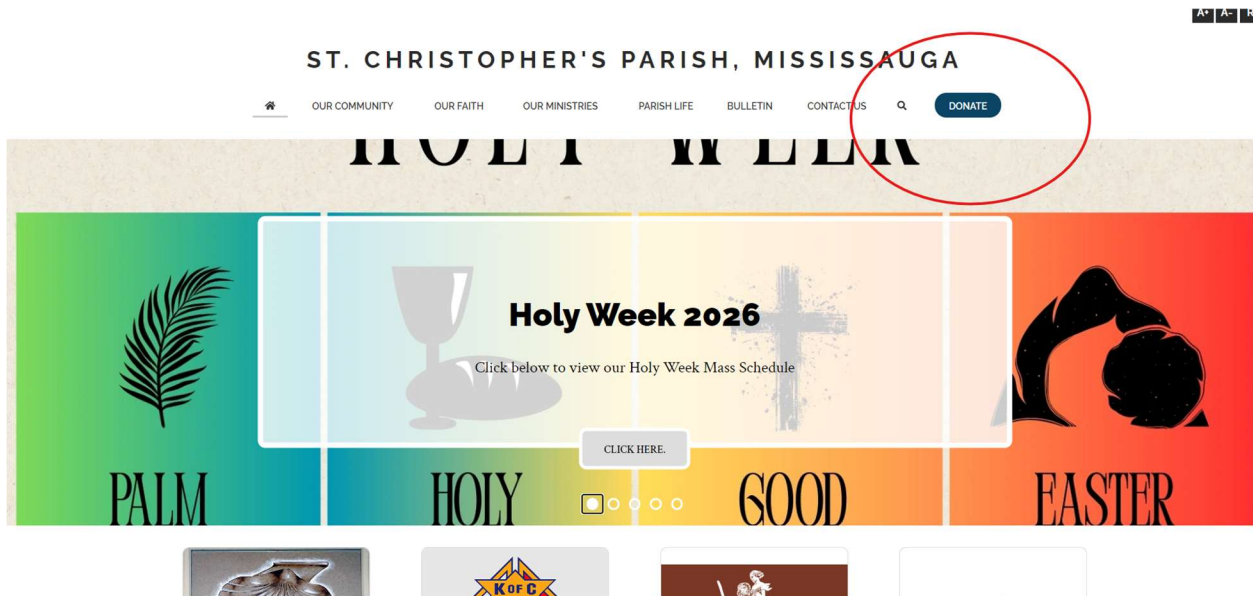


Other ways to donate to St. Christopher's

Most people will be aware that it is possible to provide financial support to our parish by direct cash donations at our Masses, by the regular use of envelopes, or by setting up pre-authorized giving (PAG) from your bank account. But there are some other ways that you may not have considered!

Online donations

If you go to the St. Christopher's website (<https://stchristophersmi.archtoronto.org/>) you will find a "Donate" button on the main menu (see below). Clicking that button will take you to a page where you can provide one-time or recurring donations to the parish, to ShareLife, or to other programs or charities in the Archdiocese of Toronto.



Bequests and other types of gifts

There are many other ways to support the parish, according to your personal circumstances. Always remember that all gifts are valuable and appreciated – not just those of the wealthy (see Mark 12:41-44).

It is possible to make a gift to St. Christopher's in your will by a bequest. It is also possible to make provision for the parish via life insurance or beneficiary designations in registered plans (such as RRSPs or RRIFs).
